



## Course Descriptor

### Child Protection: Identifying and Managing Risk

#### **Audience:**

This ½ day workshop is suitable for:

- those who have responsibility for, or are likely to be involved in, the management, supervision or support of staff or volunteers
- child protection officers or board/committee members at a Scottish governing body of sport or sports club
- local authority/leisure trust staff such as sports development officers, club development officers, Active School Co-ordinators who support local sports clubs.

#### **Workshop Pre-requisites:**

Participants attending this workshop should have first attended a basic awareness course in child protection such as 'Safeguarding and Protecting Children' or equivalent.

#### **The Workshop:**

This workshop has been developed to compliment Step 3 of *10 Steps to Safeguard Children in Sport* which can be downloaded free from [www.safeguardingsport.org.uk](http://www.safeguardingsport.org.uk).

Step 3 supports sports organisations to identify and manage risks relating to the welfare of children and young people and to protect them against harm.

#### **Workshop Aim:**

The overall aim of this workshop is to ensure that participants understand the role played by good risk assessment and management, in keeping children and young people safe, and how it can be developed and maintained in their organisation or club.

#### **Learning Outcomes:**

By the end of the course participants will:

- be clear about what risk assessment and management is
- have explored a range of ways it can be used
- considered how risk assessment and management can be further developed within their organisation or club
