#### What is payroll giving?

Payroll Giving is an easy way to make a regular donation. You can donate to Children 1st (or any UK registered charity) directly from your salary before tax with no need to share your bank details.



Payroll Giving not only gives charifies regular and reliable income, but also provides a tax-break on your donations by up to 40%.

#### **Example of how Payroll Giving and tax relief works**

Donation from Individual	Cost from take home pay (20% basic rate taxpayer)	Cost from take home pay (40% basic rate taxpayer)	Charity Receives
£5	£4	£3	£5
£10	£8	£6	£10
£25	£20	£15	£25

### How do I sign up?

Contact your payroll team. Your employer must be set up with a Payroll Giving Agency to process donations.\* When you have confirmed this, simply let them know how much and how often you would like to donate to Children 1st. You can also sign up through our online form at www.children1st.org.uk/payrollgiving.

Your donation will then start to come out of your gross salary, tax free on a regular basis, it is that simple!
